PHOENIX FUND Every Family, Every Year

The Phoenix Fund is our **annual campaign for operational support**. As a line item in our annual budget, donations supplement low per-pupil funding and **make our day-to-day operations possible**.

Our goal is to raise
\$325,000

for the **Phoenix Fund**
by March 31, 2023.

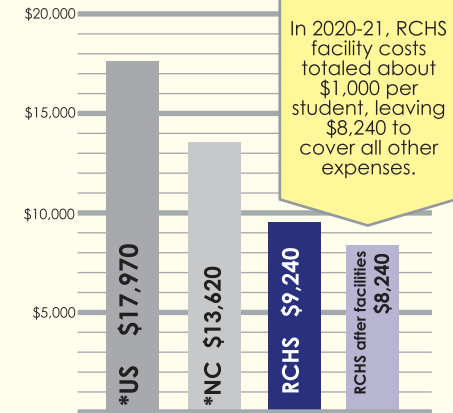
To give to the Phoenix Fund, donate to [Raleigh Charter High School](#).

Without the **annual Phoenix Fund**, we would face a difficult decision:
Increase enrollment without adding faculty
OR
Reduce the number of faculty members.
In either case, class size would increase.

Phoenix Fund dollars are critical to our budget, so we ask the families of our current students to contribute to our **Phoenix Fund first!**

We strive for **100% participation** from current families in the Phoenix Fund.

Unlike traditional public schools, RCHS does not receive funding for our school building. This means we must stretch our limited per-pupil funds to pay the mortgage on our building in addition to covering all the costs of running a school (i.g., paying salaries, buying supplies, keeping the lights on).

FOUNDATION CAMPAIGN Investing in Our Teachers, Securing Our Future

In addition to the annual Phoenix Fund, we have launched a multi-year initiative to **secure the school for the future** while also **improving compensation for our incredible teachers**.

Contributions to the Foundation Campaign will make it possible for us to **pay off the mortgage on our building**, which will free up the funds necessary to **raise salaries for our dedicated faculty**.

Our goal is to raise
\$1.5 million

for the **Foundation Campaign**
by summer 2024.

RCHS faculty are incredible educators!

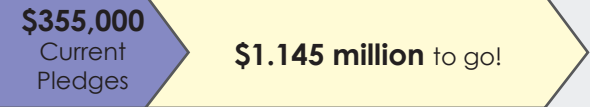
- The average RCHS teacher has **19 years of teaching experience**.
- 71% of our teachers have **advanced degrees**.
- More than half of our teachers have taught at **RCHS for 10 years or more** -- 18 of them have **taught here for at least 15 years**.
- This year, we have **5 RCHS alumni on staff**.
